

## October 2005 Water/Sewer Billing Rates

**Water Consumption Rates** for metered sales of water within the corporate limits of the Village:

SEMIANNUAL CONSUMPTION	RATE
(cubic feet)	(per thousand cubic feet)
Up to 4,000 CF (conversion rate)	\$69.83
4,001 to 7,000 CF (includes multi-residential Only units such as condo's/co-op's/apartments)	\$76.81 (for consumption > 4,000 CF)
7,001 to 10,000 CF	\$83.82 (for consumption > 7,000 CF)
10,001 to 15,000 CF	\$90.80 (for consumption > 10,000 CF)
Over 15,001 CF	\$97.79 (for consumption > 15,000 CF)
Over 10,001 CF for commercial and Industrial only use	\$87.29 (for consumption > 10,000 CF)

Rates for metered sales of water outside of the corporate limits of the Village are double the above rates.

**Sewer Rates** for sewer service charges:

Up to 7,000 CF	\$10.96	\$10.96
7,001 to 10,000 CF	\$10.96	\$11.82

Over 15,000 CF	\$10.96	\$14.10

**Water Meter Service Fee:**

**Residential Customers \$15.00 per each residential unit**  
**Residential Customers \$20.00 for single residential home with 1" meter**  
**Non-Residential Customers (commercial, industrial, etc.)**

**Note: Both non-residential and residential use on one meter shall be subject to a charge for the meter based on the meter size above, plus \$15 for each residential unit feeding from the meter.**

**Note: No additional charge for each additional non-residential user feeding from the meter.**

**Penalties:**

Penalties of 10% on delinquent water and sewer balances (30 days after water and sewer services are billed). Additional penalty will be added for unpaid water and sewer rents that are levied on the Village Tax Roll.

**Water and Sewer Fee Charges for Services:**

Note: Water and sewer fee charges were adopted by local law in April 2005 (see Village Code). Included is a \$100.00 per man-hour charge for meter re-reads (\$300 minimum on Saturdays and \$450 on Sundays and holidays).

**Use of ACH Electronic Debits:**

Notice: Consumer checks submitted for payment of water and sewer rents may be converted into a one-time electronic debit from your account at the financial institution indicated on your check. This electronic debit will be for the amount of your check; no additional amount will be added to the check amount.
